Experience	Minimum one year Research Experience in the area of organic synthesis
Fellowship	Rs.31,000/- + HRA
Tenure of the post	6 months, extendable up to 1 year based on performance
Age	JRF: 28 years with 3-5 years relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/Women and Physically disabled as per government norms.
What to bring	Complete CV, Certificates of qualifying degrees (original + one copy), valid ID card, one page statement of interest, a photograph, and reprints of papers. Research experience should be supported by certificate from the employer(s).

5. Applicants who do not meet the minimum criteria will not be considered. The prescribed educational qualifications are the bare minimum and mere possession of same does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview.
