This tender document has been published on the Central Public Procurement Portal (<u>URL:https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>) & Institute website <u>www.iisertvm.ac.in</u>. The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal. - 1.1 The intending bidder must read the terms and condition of NIT carefully. Bidder should submit hisbid only if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the required documents.
- 1.2 Bid documents should be submitted online complete in all respect along with requisite amount of tender fee (cost of bid documents). Cost of tender documents shall be remitted to IISER TVM by online payment through **State Bank Collect**. Complete set of tender documents comprising Volume I, II has been made available at e-tender portal (URL:https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app)
- 1.3 The bidder would be required to register at e-tender portal (<u>URL:http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u> For submission of the bids, the bidder is required to have digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the authorized Certifying Authorities.
- 1.4 Information and instruction for bidders posted on website shall form part of the bid document.
- 1.5 The bid document consisting of Vol.I Tender conditions, Vol-II- Financial Bid (BOQ) and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website (<u>URL:https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>)free of cost.
- 1.6 But the bid can only be submitted after uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as receipt of online payment towards tender fee, in favour of IISER THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, scan copies of other required documents as specified in the NIT. The tender fee should be deposited online with IISER THIRUVANANTHAPURAM within the period of bid submission as specified in the bid document.

- 1.7 Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can get imparted to training on online tendering process as per details available on the website. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
- 1.8 On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
- 1.9 Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format. Certificate of Financial Turn over: At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/ Certificate from CA mentioning Financial Turnover oflast3yearsorforthe period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet.
- 1.10Contractor has to quote item rate the total estimated cost put to tender and in case bidder quote % rate in the BOQ, then tender shall be rejected.
- 1.11The tender document can be downloaded from <u>http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u> and be submitted only through the same website.

### 2. Registration of Bidder on e-Procurement Portal

- 2.1 Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (<u>URL:http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u>) by clicking on the link "Click here to Enroll". Enrolment on the CPP Portal is free of charge.
- 2.2 As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique user name and assign a password for their accounts.
- 2.3 Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registrationprocess. These would be used for any communication from the CPPP ortal.
- 2.4 Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify/TCS/nCode/eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 2.5 Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse.
- 2.6 Bidder then logs into the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID/password and the password of the DSC / eToken.

### 3. SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- 3.1 There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as organization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 3.2 Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS/e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3.3 The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

### 4. PREPARATION OF BIDS

- 4.1 Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 4.2 Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 4.3 Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option.
- 4.4 To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

### 5. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 5.1 Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he/she upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 5.2 The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 5.3 A standard BOQ format has been provided with the tender document to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids

in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. Bidders are required to download the

BOQ file, open it and complete the white colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submititonline, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

- 5.4 The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- 5.5 The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- 5.6 Upon the successful and timely submission of bids, the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.

- 7. ### 8. Bid Security/EMD and Tender fee.

- 9.1 Bid Security/EMD amounting to Rs. 8,720/-and tender fee of Rs. 560/-( Including 12% GST charges) shall be deposited in IISER THIRUVANANTHAPURAM Bank account through State Bank Collect as detailed below failing which the bid will be declared non responsive. - 9.4 A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, 50% of earnest money or Rs.20 lakh, whichever is less, will have to be deposited in shape prescribed above and balance in shape of irrevocable Bank Guarantee from a Scheduled Bank and shall be valid 120 days from the last date of receipt of bid as per standard proforma attached.
- 9.5 Scanned copy of the net banking transaction receipt towards payment of tender fee shall be uploaded on the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission failing which the bid will be declared non responsive.
- 9.6 Bid Security/EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned to them within 90 days from the date of acceptance of bid of the successful Bidder.
- 9.7 The Bid Security/EMD may be forfeited, if
  - a) The bidder withdraws / modifies his Bid or any item thereof after opening of bid.
  - b) The successful Bidder fails within the specified time limit to commence the work.

- 12. The uploading quotation in pre-revised BOQ shall be considered as a willful negligence by the bidder and his quotation shall be considered as non-responsive.

### 13. Cost of Bidding

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his Bid, and the IISER THIRUVANANTHAPURAM will in no case be responsible and liable for these costs.

### 14. Site visit & availability of site.

- a) The Bidder should inform the IISER in advance about the proposed site visit.
- b) The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit, inspect and Survey the Site and its surroundings and satisfy himself before submitting his Bid as to the form and nature of the Site, the means of access to the Site, the Accommodation he may require etc.
- c) In general, Bidders shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A Bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the Site, whether he inspects it or not and no extra claims due to any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
- d) The costs of visiting the Site shall be at the Bidders' own expense. Any report shared at the site, by the IISER is subject to verification by the contractor. Any deviations of information in the report and the actual site will not be the responsibility of the IISER.
- e) The site for the work is available for visit from the date of issue of the tender.
- f) The architectural and structural drawings shall be made available in phased manner as per requirement of the same as per approved program of completion submitted by the contractor after award of the work.

### 15. Content of Bidding Documents

- a) Submission of a bid by a Bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be executed and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the works.
- b) The Bidder shall submit the Bid, which satisfies each and every condition laid down in the Bid documents, failing which, the bid is liable to be rejected.

### 16. Amendment of Bid Documents

Before the deadline for submission of bids, the IISER THIRUVANANTHAPURAM may modify the bidding documents by issuing corrigendum. Any corrigendum so issued shall be part of the bid documents as well as Contract document and shall be on uploaded website <u>URL:https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</u> and <u>www.iisertvm.ac.in</u> Bidders should take note of the uploaded corrigendum and submit the tenders accordingly.

### 17. Bid Validity

The bids submitted shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of the technical bids. If any bidder withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the IISER, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, then the IISER, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidder shall not be allowed to participate in the any tendering process of IISER TVM for a period of 3 years.

### 18. Bid Opening

- a) Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose tender fee and EMD is deposited online with IISER THIRUVANANTHAPURAM and scanned their scanned copies i/c tender documents scanned and uploaded are found in order. On the due date and appointed time as specified in clause 11. IISER, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM will first open Envelope – I of bid. Bidders satisfying conditions of 19.1, including amendment as per clause 17 if applicable, in the presence of the Bidders or their representatives who choose to attend In the event of the specified date for Bid opening being declared a holiday by the IISER, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, and the Bids will be opened at the appointed time and location on the next working day.

### 19. Clarification of Bids

- b) No, Bidder shall contact the IISER, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM on any matter relating to his bid from the time of the bid opening to the time the contract is awarded.
- c) Any effort by the Bidder to influence the IISER's bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions, may result in the rejection of his bid.
- d) Indian Institute of Science Education and Research THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid, and reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reasons. The Board of Governors of IISER reserves the right to accept or reject any application and to annul the pre-qualification process and reject all applications at any time, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected applicants or specifying the grounds for the Employer's action

## Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and Guidelines for Construction Sites for COVID-19 Outbreak

The following standard operating procedures and guidelines shall be followed:-A. General Guidelines:

- 1. Thermal Scanning of everyone entering and exiting a construction site will be done for fever with thermal scanners. If anyone leaves and re-enters the site during the shift, rescreening of the individual will be done prior to re-entry into the work site.
- 2. PPE and Other material requirement shall be provided as per requirement.
- 3. Provision for hand wash & sanitizer (touch free recommended) will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas (including at distant locations like higher floors). Everyone will be required to wash & sanitize his/her hands before entering the site and using PPEs. Same procedure to be followed after removing PPEs and exiting the premise. Sufficient quantities of all the items should be available at the site.
- 4. All Protocol including Emergency Response will be laid out. Periodic tailgate sessions will be arranged to review site protocols in view of highly dynamic scenario ensuring social distancing norms. During these sessions, everyone including workers will be informed about the safety guidelines and important updates. Necessary arrangements for announcements shall be made at every site.
- 5. Mandatory use of PPEs (face mask, hand gloves and other as applicable) by everyone entering the premise. Re-usable PPEs should be thoroughly cleaned and should not be shared with others.
- 6. Entire construction site including site office, labour camp, canteens, pathways, toilets, and entry / exit gates will be disinfected on daily basis. Housekeeping team should be provided with necessary PPEs.
- 7. There will be total Ban on non-essential visitors at sites (including from Head office staff, consultants etc.).
- 8. There will be strict ban on Gutka, Tambaku, Paan etc. on site and spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
- 9. Food should be consumed at designated areas only ensuring social distancing.
- 10. Common sitting arrangements should be removed.
- 11. Post lunch, waste should be disposed by individual in designated bins and area should remain clean.
- 12. Areas with a probability of bigger gathering, for eg. cleaning area, toilets etc. should be identified and all arrangements should be made to ensure social distancing.
- 13. A doctor will be present periodically (at least once a week) at site on allotted time for any medical assistance.
- 14. Appropriate signage at construction site spelling out safety practices in the language which is understood by all
- 15. Hospital/clinics in the nearby area, which are authorized to treat COVID- '19 patients, should be identified and list should be available at Site all the time
- 16. For any confusion, clarification and update, everyone should approach designated authority or rely on authentic source
- 17. Rumours shall be discouraged and offenders be warned
- 18. An isolation room shall be created at site

### **B.** Guidelines for Workers:

- 1. On day 0, before resuming the work on site post lockdown period, mandatory medical check-up will be arranged for all workers. The workers coming from outside will be quarantined for a period of at least 15 days. Only medically fit workers will be deployed at site and medical assistance will be arranged for unfit workers. Medical checkup camp should be arranged every month.
- 2. The labours staying at site will not be allowed to go outside. All the essential items will be made available to labours at site only. If necessary, the workers can go out wearing PPEs, after informing supervisor. Similarly, no outside labour will be allowed at site without following proper procedure and instructions.
- 3. Start time on site will be staggered to avoid congestion at the entry gates. Number of workers working at a particular time / place will be reduced by making arrangements for different shifts / areas. Accordingly, additional staff such as security guards, supervisors etc. will be deployed.
- 4. As in most cases, workers reside at the Sites, hence there is no need for any travel. For Workers staying outside, (which are always nearby) special transportation facility will be arranged without any dependency on the public transport system.
- 5. During attendance, training and other sessions, social distancing guidelines will be followed along with provision of no touch attendance.
- 6. Workers should not shake hands when greeting others and while working on the site.
- 7. Workers shall avoid contact with sick people and avoid going to site if they are feeling sick, have fever, cough or shortness of breath. In such case, supervisor should be informed immediately.
- 8. Workers with such symptoms should not come to site and should be placed in isolation and medical assistance will be provided on immediate basis.
- 9. Mandatorily wear face masks while working on site. While not wearing masks, worker shall cover his mouth and nose with tissues.
- 10. Cough/sneeze should be done in the crook of one's arm and your elbow.
- 11. Avoid large gatherings or meetings of 10 people or more. Stay at least 6 feet away from others on job sites and in gatherings, meetings, and training sessions.
- 12. Not more lhan 214 persons (depending on size) will be allowed to travel in lifts or hoists. Use of staircase for climbing should be encouraged.
- 13. Workers should clean hands frequently by washing them with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. When hand washing isn't possible, alcohol based hand sanitizer with greater than 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol should be used.
- 14. Workers should not share their belongings like food, water bottles, utensils, mobile phones etc. with others.
- 15. The utensils should be washed properly post use at designated place.
- 16. Post work, workers should change their clothes before leaving the site and clothing should not be shook out.
- 17. Avoid touching eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.

### C. Guidelines for Material, Tools. Machinery, Vehicles etc:-

- 1. Wipe down interiors and door handle of machines or construction vehicles, the handles of equipment and tools that are shared, with disinfectant prior to using.
- 2. Non-touch waste bin with disposable garbage bag should be installed for waste collection at all common access areas.
- 3. Proper disposal of garbage should be ensured.
- 4. At all point of time, easy access to parking should be ensured since public transit is limited.
- 5. All construction material arriving at site should be left idle for 3 days before use to ensure safe usage.
- 6. All vehicles and machinery entering the premise should be disinfected by spray mandatorily.

## D. Emergency protocol in case of detection of symptoms of COVID 19 to be observed by Project Manager of Contractor:-

- 1. Immediate shift worker to isolation room. Inform the Engineer-Incharge, IISER or the Nodal officer in IISER
- 2. Call for a doctor.
- 3. Keep worker under observation for a few days in isolation room. In case of doubt act per advice of local doctor.
- 4. COVID testing shall be arranges as per instruction of Doctor and if so advised by Doctor, move worker to Hospital.
- 5. Prevent rumours and take strict action against those who spread it.
